## Here's how to use PennDOT's Emergency Contact Information System

- Visit www.dmv.state.pa.us and click on the Emergency Contact Upload icon.
- Enter the Driver's License or Pennsylvania ID number, date of birth and the last four digits of the social security number for you or the person for whom you are entering emergency contact information.
- 3. Enter the contact information for one primary and if available, one secondary emergency contact. You will be required to include their name, relationship to the person for whom the information is being entered, address and a phone number.
- 4. You'll then have the opportunity to submit, edit or cancel the information.
