This application cannot be used as a substitute for an appeal from an allegedly erroneous appraisement, the disallowance of deductions or an incorrect assessment of tax. See Section 9186 of the 1995 Act (72 P.S. §9186) for correct procedure with respect to such appeals.

Should the estate believe that a refund is due as the result of an issue which had not previously been raised, and where the statutory appeal provisions of Section 9186 (a) of the 1995 Act have expired, a petition for refund may be filed with the Board of Appeals providing that all taxes which have been assessed are paid in full.
