

DONATE NAMED ACTING WARDEN

Scranton, PA ---Lackawanna County Commissioners A.J. Munchak, Robert C. Cordaro, Michael Washo and members of the Prison Board have appointed Janine M. Donate, 37 to the post of acting Warden for the Lackawanna County Prison. Mrs. Donate brings fourteen years of training, management and supervisory experience to the position. She will earn \$57,000.

Warden Donate served as Assistant Warden of Security at the Lackawanna County Prison overseeing operations and activities of the prison's security division and the continuing implementation of measures designed for the security, custody and inmate control of the inmate population. She has participated in staff training, development of emergency plans as well as establishment and implementation of crisis management.

Prior to taking her position in 2004 at the Lackawanna County Prison Warden Donate served as Staff Training and Development Lieutenant at the Monroe County Correctional Facility. As Lieutenant, Donate was responsible for the basic training for new officers and the on-going training of current staff. She has received state accreditation of the Training Program for Monroe County. She is certified in CPR, first aid as well suicide prevention and special needs of inmates and staff sexual misconduct.

“The Board is confident that the progress made so far in improving the prison will continue under her guidance,” said Commissioner A.J. Munchak.

Mrs. Donate received her Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology with a concentration in Criminal Justice from East Stroudsburg University. She currently resides in Moscow with her husband and their two daughters.
