Lackawanna County 4-H Photography Contest



Three Age Divisions:

Ages 8 to 11
Ages 12 to 15
Ages 16 to 19



3 Winners per Division:

1st - \$50 gift certificate
2nd - \$25 gift certificate
3rd - \$10 gift certificate

You are not required to be a 4-H member – anyone from age 8-19 can enter!

Whether you only take the occasional picture or never set your camera down, show off your talents in photography by entering. You may be a winner!

Contest Rules:

- ◆ Photo must relate to the theme “Making the 4-H Connection” - 4-H projects can be viewed on our web site at <http://pa4h.cas.psu.edu/Projects.html>
- ◆ A brief statement, maximum of 100 words, that explains why the photo goes along with the theme “Making the 4-H Connection” must be included
- ◆ Entry person must be of 4-H age (8 to 19), however, entry person doesn't have to be a 4-H member
- ◆ Three different age groups will be judged: ages 8-11; 12-15; and 16-19
- ◆ The individual entering must live in Lackawanna County
- ◆ All photographs must be taken by the individual entering
- ◆ No professional photography!
- ◆ One entry per person
- ◆ Photos cannot be larger than 4" X 6" and should not be framed
- ◆ Photos become the property of Lackawanna County 4-H and can be used for publicity purposes
- ◆ Photos will not be returned to the sender
- ◆ Your name, address, telephone number, and birth date must be written on the back of the photo (unless the photo is sent digital - in this case make sure these items are listed in the e-mail sent along with the photograph)
- ◆ For digital entries, the subject title should read; 4-H Photo Contest, e-mail address is LackawannaExt@psu.edu
- ◆ Surface mail address: 4-H Photo Contest, Penn State Cooperative Extension in Lackawanna County, 200 Adams Avenue, LL, Scranton, PA 18503-1695
- ◆ Entries may also be hand delivered to the Cooperative Extension Office between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:00 pm Monday through Friday
- ◆ Deadline is **4pm Monday, September 26** – the photograph must be in the Penn State Extension Office by this time, late entries will not be accepted
- ◆ Winners will be contacted by telephone by a 4-H Extension Educator and given recognition in the newspaper during National 4-H Week, October 2-8, 2005
