RIBBON CUTTING MARKS COMPLETION OF GLENMAURA BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

MOOSIC, PA---The Lackawanna County Commissioners joined State and Moosic Borough officials today for a ribbon cutting ceremony marking the completion of a roadway improvement project along Glenmaura Boulevard on Montage Mountain in Moosic, Lackawanna County.

"We are happy to take action to help the residents and businesses throughout Moosic and the Glenmaura Development. The Glenmaura Development has been a model for the type of growth we hope to achieve elsewhere in Lackawanna County and it is critical to continue investing and improving the infrastructure here," said Commissioner Robert. C. Cordaro.

Glenmaura Boulevard is approximately one mile long and connects Montage Mountain Road and PA Route 502. The roadway provides access to the Glenmaura National Golf Club and is an alternate route to and from the many attractions and businesses on Montage Mountain.

The \$467,000 Glenmaura Boulevard improvement project included new pavement, pavement widening, paved shoulders, minor drainage improvements, and guide rail and pavement markings. Work began earlier this fall and is now complete. The construction contractor is Don E. Bower, Inc, Berwick, PA. The improvement project was paid for with 80% federal and 20% local funds.
