2. PURPOSE:

6. CRITERIA FOR EVALUTION OF BIDS:

The Board will independently evaluate each bid and selection will be made upon the following criteria:

- * Cost of services/items.
- * The Bidder's demonstrated experience and expertise in road paving.
- * Experience and commitment to providing timely services.
- * Project understanding and methodology.

7. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Each Bid must be in sufficient detail to permit evaluation, at a minimum, with respect to the following issues. Bids must include the information that is specifically requested herein as well as such additional information as a respondent deems relevant to the process. Each respondent agrees that the Bid constitutes a firm offer to the County that cannot be withdrawn for ninety (90) days from the Bid due date.

To achieve a maximum degree of comparability, the Bids shall be organized in the manner specified below and use corresponding lettering and/or numbering.

Title Page:

(1 page): Show name of your firm, address, name of contact, telephone number(s) and email address along with the current date. Also include the title and number of the RFB.

Table of Contents:

All Bids to the County must include the following:

SECTION 1	Scope of Services as it applies to this RFB and all bid and alternate bid values. All Bids must detail the
	services/items proposed along with any supporting materials.

SECTION 2 Name, address, and description of your firm along with a brief history.

SECTION 3 A list of five (5) references, including name of institution, address, contact person and phone number.

SECTION 4 A statement of assurance that your firm is not currently in violation of any regulatory rules and regulations that may have any impact on your firm's operations.

SECTION 5 A statement that your firm or principals are not involved in any current or pending litigation involving Lackawanna County or any of its Departments or Authorities.

SECTION 6 Statement of assurance that there are no conflicts of interest

8. RESPONSIBILITIES:

The successful Bid shall have primary responsibility for the following:

* Bituminous Paving and Paving Repair

9. CONFIDENTIALITY:

All Bids in response to this RFB shall be held confidential until a contract is awarded. Following the contract award, Bids are subject to release as public information unless the Bid or specific parts of the Bid can be shown to be exempt from the Pennsylvania Public Information Act. Respondents are advised to consult with their legal counsel regarding disclosure issues and take the appropriate precautions to safeguard trade secrets or any other proprietary information. The County assumes no obligation or responsibility for asserting legal arguments on behalf of potential Respondents. If a Respondent believes that a Bid or parts of a Bid are confidential, then the Respondent shall so specify. The Respondent shall stamp in bold red letters the term "CONFIDENTIAL" on that part of the Bid, which the Respondent believes to be confidential. Vague and general claims as to confidentiality shall not be accepted. All Bids and parts of Bids that are not marked as confidential will be automatically considered public information after the contract is awarded.

10. CONFLICT OF INTEREST:

Any vendor or person considering doing business with Lackawanna County Government must disclose the vendor or person's affiliation or relationship that might cause a "Conflict of Interest" with County Government entity. Any attempt to intentionally or unintentionally conceal or obfuscate a conflict of interest may automatically result in the disqualification of the Respondent's bid.

All communications during this process should be directed to the appropriate contact listed in this Request for Bids. Any firm that makes any effort to communicate with any other official of Lackawanna County, either directly or indirectly, during this process will be EXCLUDED from consideration.
