- -professional collection practices must adhere to all applicable state and local laws, please state if your company or any of its principals or employees were ever cited for any infractions,
- -provide professional liability coverage in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.00 and name the County of Lackawanna as an additional insured,

The RFP will be reviewed for the following;

The pricing proposal shall be separate from the qualification data. THE PRICING PROPOSAL MUST BE WRITTEN IN A CONCISE FASHION ON A SEPARATE PAPER FROM THE RFQ AND PLACED IN A SEPARATE SEALED ENVELOPE. The proposal must be inclusive of the following;

- -a listing of all fees that will be charged to the delinquent files,
- -a release fee to be charged the county for files that the county asks to be returned before the collection process is implemented or concluded,
- -any other fees the contractor deems appropriate.
