## Dump the Pump and Save Money

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System (COLTS) will participate in the Sixth Annual Dump the Pump Day on Thursday, June 16, 2011.

“Riding the bus is one of the best ways to beat high gas prices, and in these tough economic times, that is something we are all trying to do,” said Executive Director Bob Fiume.

COLTS will offer free rides on all its routes all day long on June 16 to promote the use of public transportation. COLTS staff will also have giveaways and prizes at the bus hub in the 100 block of Wyoming Avenue in downtown Scranton.
