Merli-Sarnoski Park

The 840-acre park known for its pristine natural beauty has miles of mountain biking and hiking trails, lake swimming, picnic areas and a handicapped accessible fishing pier. Stop by and visit the horses at the Lackawanna County Sheriff's Department stables!



Park Amenities:

- 35-acre lake stocked by the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission
- Two pavilions
- Large handicapped accessible fishing pier
- Beautiful sandy beach area with bath houses
- Boat launch (electric motors only)
- 15 miles of hiking, mountain bike and nature trails
- Picnic areas with tables and charcoal grills
- Two playground areas with basketball and volleyball courts
- Regulation soccer field
- Lackawanna County Sheriff's Department horse stables

Directions: From the Casey Highway (U.S. Route 6), take Exit 5, Route 107. Take Rt. 107 approx. 4 miles, make right on Sandy Banks Road. Look for Park entrance after 3.4 miles.
