## McDade Park Amenities:

- Inclusive Boundless Playground
- An Olympic-sized swimming pool with bath house
- Children's fishing pond stocked several times a year
- Basketball and tennis courts
- Softball field
- Two pavilions
- Outdoor picnic areas with charcoal grills
- Two-mile cross country running course and hiking trail system
- Lackawanna Coal Mine Tour Complex with concession stand and gift shop
- Pennsylvania Anthracite Heritage Museum and gift shop
- Cancer Memorial Garden and arboretum
- Bocce courts
- Multipurpose field for soccer and lacrosse
- Free sports equipment rentals
- Large, open fields for Frisbee in the summer and cross country skiing in the winter

## Merli-Sarnoski Park Amenities:

- 35-acre lake stocked by the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission
- Two pavilions
- Large handicapped accessible fishing pier
- Beautiful sandy beach area with bath houses
- Boat launch (electric motors only)
- 15 miles of hiking, mountain bike and nature trails
- Picnic areas with tables and charcoal grills
- Two playground areas with basketball and volleyball courts
- Regulation soccer field
- Lackawanna County Sheriff's Department horse stables

*Directions: From the Casey Highway (U.S. Route 6), take Exit 5, Route 107. Take Rt. 107 approx. 4 miles, make right on Sandy Banks Road. Look for Park entrance after 3.4 miles.*

- Four-acre lake with beach
- Fishing in lake stocked by the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission
- Playing Fields\*
- Inclusive Boundless Playground\*
- Pavilion complex that can be reserved for groups of up to 150 people
- Lake trail

- Picnic tables and grills
