DOUGLAS FIR
(*Pseudotsuga menziesii*)

An excellent Christmas tree and ornamental. Shiny, dark, silvery green foliage with a silvery underside and superb needle retention. Does best in moist well drained soils. Does not require full sun. A beautiful tree with an excellent rate of growth and color.

WHITE PINE
(*Pinus strobus*)

A native species to northeast Pennsylvania. A very hearty pine tree with long, soft, blue-green needles. Great for landscaping, windbreaks, timber or Christmas trees. Likes well drained soils but can tolerate wet conditions.

PEAR TREES
(*Pyrus*)

An order consists of one Harrow Sweet and one Potomac pear tree. Both varieties are vigorous and resistant to blight. Excellent fruit for canning or eating fresh. These are standard size trees, but can be trimmed to desired height.

PLUM TREES
(*Prunus*)

An order consist of one Stanley and one Green Gage plum tree. The trees are early bearing, productive and hardy. Fruit is dark blue-purple in color. Trees are standard size but can be trimmed to desired height.

APPLE TREES (semi-dwarf)
(*Malus*)

An order consists of one Northern Spy and one Ginger Gold apple tree. The trees are bare root whips which are approximately 4' to 5' tall to 1/2" and 3/4" in diameter. The Spy is a red apple while the Ginger Gold is a yellow apple and are both good for a variety of purposes. Both varieties are well suited to the back yard grower. They are vigorous and productive. Select a well-drained area with full sun and plant 15' apart. These semi-dwarf trees grow 12' to 20' tall. Root stock is EmLA 111 and EmLA7.

BLUEBERRY BUSHES
(*Vaccinium*)

An order consists of two potted plants obtained from a local berry farm and are very hardy. Plants are of bearing age and with care, will develop large flavorful berries. Select a sunny well-drained site with sandy or loamy soil. You may need to add soil amendments. Sold in pairs to provide cross-species pollination The two varieties are Legacy and Jersey.

RASPBERRY PLANTS
(*Rabus idaeus*)

An order consists of one red raspberry plant. Raspberries are very popular with home growers. Planting should be done in areas with good drainage and full sun. It is recommended planting be done in rows with each plant 2-3' apart..

YELLOW RHODODENDRON
(*Rhododendron xkosterum*)

A compact and rounded evergreen with fragrant yellow blooms which maintain their color throughout the spring. Maturing height is between 3-4'. Can be used as a foundation plant, border or hedge.

STRAWBERRY PLANTS
(*Fragaria*)

An order consists of 25 strawberry vine plugs. The flavorful variety is "Tristar" which is a late season ever-bearing strawberry. A good cropper.
