Commissioner Michael J. Washo- Thank you to all who are here-Finances are in consideration-the Federal/State/Local Government are all making cuts due to the economic times

Evening meetings have indeed been held for the Budget the Board goes to three different sites in the County-it is well advertised, and no-one shows up "We are taxpayers", and this Wi-Fi has the potential to bring more money, and much more business into the area- it's a good move

Commissioner Corey D. O'Brien- It is the installation of a wireless infrastructure, not Wi-Fi, a wireless network; Private sector doesn't provide the backbone wireless that this will set out to achieve; there are things that the private sector doesn't build- we don't have a competing private sector interest with respect to what we are contemplating here-

Under Federal Law, Act 183 Petition Filing; if we want to do anything that will be in competition with the private sector; and if there is any local business, and private sector that wants to do that business, then they can. There is no one in the private sector, in Lackawanna County, which can provide this network

The funding is in the Budget; phones, data connections and connectivity will be eliminated in the budget if this wireless network is installed The record is fairly clear: we've reduced the workforce by 33%-not an easy decision, but the right one. Reduced expenditures by \$17 million dollars- was that an easy decision? No, was it the right decision? Yes. Reduced the size of the Budget- was that an easy decision? No, was it the right decision? Absolutely

This wireless network instead of the landline network that we use now will save us approx \$70,000 a year; this project will make Government more efficient, will provide our Emergency responders instantaneous access to information, will improve communications for our hand-held radios for the Sheriff's Department

Commissioner Michael J. Washo-one reason we are able to do a project like this, are the towers we have which are worth a quarter of a million dollars at late worth, which enable us to do this at not a great expense, enable us to save money-make the County more efficient, and possible to provide a service that the private sector doesn't want to provide
