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CALL FOR MURAL ARTISTS LACKAWANNA COUNTY – BRIDGE MURAL MOSCOW BORUGH and JESSUP BOROUGH COMPETITION

(NOTE budget and supply list not required as possibly stated)

Lackawanna County is sponsoring a mural competition for two rail bridges in Moscow and Jessup Boroughs. Experienced mural artists are invited to submit designs capturing the essence of these boroughs. The winning design will be selected by the respective boroughs and selected artists will be notified in August. 2014 and have until November 1, 2014 to complete murals. Artists may submit designs for both bridges. Moscow bridge award is \$9,000 and Jessup Bridge is \$8,000. Supplies and any equipment are the responsibility of the artist. Bridges must be complete no later than November 1, 2014.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be at least 18 years old and reside in Northeastern, PA including the counties of Lackawanna, Luzerne, Monroe, Wyoming, Pike, Wayne or Susquehanna. Artists <u>MUST</u> have previous experience painting murals. Applicants without previous experience will not be considered. Artists may apply to paint one or both bridges but separate applications must be submitted.

DESIGN AREA:

The competition requires artists to paint both entrances into the bridges including the top of the bridge and the winged sides. Inside of bridge does not have to be painted except for the town name and date established somewhere on the inside. Please see photos and specifications.

There will be a separate award for each bridge as each has its own specifications. Artist is responsible for obtaining paint and other supplies including any equipment that has to be rented. The county will only be issuing the cash awards which were calculated factoring in cost of supplies, equipment rental and labor. An artist may submit an application for both bridges.

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APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Artists must have previous mural experience and submit their background with murals in the application. Unqualified applicants will not be eligible. Review design specifications and submit the following through email to arts-culture@lackawannacounty.org

- A. Design Art Work: Should reflect the unique character of Jessup and Moscow. Only the sides of the bridges and top (part under rail road track) should be designed-not the curved interior-although the name and date borough was established should be painted inside. Please send high quality .jpegs of at least 300 dpi.

SELECTION PROCESS AND AWARD

Jessup and Moscow Boroughs will put together separate review panels with the aid of Lackawanna County to choose the mural they feel best represents their boroughs. Selected artists will be notified by the end of August, 2014. The artist for the Moscow Bridge will receive \$9,000 and the Jessup Bridge will receive \$8,000. The award amount is to cover labor and supplies. The artist is responsible for securing supplies and items such as scaffolding, scissor lift, etc. In exchange for the award, the selected artist agrees will sign an agreement with Lackawanna County who will have exclusive rights to the mural design, although the artist will maintain overall rights to the design.

Theme and Style

and date established painted somewhere inside-to be determined after design

selection.

Design Guidelines: Designs should capture the flavor and identity of the respective boroughs and

what makes them each unique. Things to consider: history, people, contemporary life, landscape, organizations, schools, sports, festivals, industries, recreation, etc. Artists are encouraged to research and visit the

boroughs.
