Lackawanna County Call for 2015 Art in the Park Artists

Lackawanna County is seeking visual and performing artists who enjoy working with children ages 4-12 to work at our Art in the Park program this summer.

This year's schedule is:

Tuesday, July 7, 2015	Merli-Sarnoski, Greenfield Twp.	10:00-12:00 p.m.
Tuesday, July 14, 2015	Covington Park, Covington Twp.	10:00-12:00 p.m.
Tuesday, July 21, 2015	Aylesworth Park, Jermyn	10:00-12:00 p.m.
Tuesday, July 28, 2015	McDade Park, Scranton	10:00-12:00 p.m.

The program takes place outside under a pavilion/and or tent. Each visual artist will have their own picnic table. Performing artists can stroll or station themselves in the grassy areas. There may also be an additional tent available. The activities that work best are come–and-go/ immediate hands-on interactive activities. Simple is best but they should also be fun and interesting. Use your imagination! Think inexpensive, creative and easy for supplies.

Ages range from 4 -12 with the average age 8. The children do not register ahead of time, but on average approx.125-150 children at each park. Artists are expected to arrive at least 30 minutes in advance and tables are at a first come first serve basis.

If you have worked at Art in the Park in the past and have done the same activity two years in a row, please provide a new activity as we have many people returning to this program.

The rate of pay is \$175/day for Performing Artist and \$200/day for Visual Artist/Table Artist (must purchase own supplies). The County takes a minimum of 30 days for payment and artists must provide a W-9 form and invoice for payment.

Proposals are reviewed by the Art in the Park committee. If selected, you will receive a letter with instructions and an Art in the Park Committee Member will also contact you with information. We are planning to notify artists in late May.

If interested, you must submit the following information:

- 1. The application for 2015, Art in the Park
- 2. Your proposal of an art activity
- 3. Your resume or bio, one page
