The case workers and foster families of Lackawanna County are so grateful to the community members who help to make children's wishes come true. It was hundreds of individuals, corporations and community groups who came together last year to provide toys, clothes and other gifts for over 1,000 children. The Angel Program is an incredible initiative that depends entirely on the goodwill of volunteers and community sponsors.

This year several of the Foster Parents are helping to coordinate the Angel Program and so things will be a little different. All gifts will be dropped off at a store front location at the Steamtown Mall. Each child will do an individualized Santa Letter and we will make every effort to match the age and gender you request. However, please remember that an exact match may not be possible. The children we work with are between the ages of birth and 21. Once we get your request, we will send you the "Letter to Santa" written by the "ANGEL" you sponsored. If you have e-mail, we can scan and e-mail your Angel letters to you

In an effort to assure that all children in a family receive a somewhat equitable amount of gifts from Santa, we are asking that you spend about \$100 per child. Please know that we are aware not everyone can afford this amount. Therefore, rather than individually sponsor a child you may want to join in with other people to sponsor a child or consider a monetary donation, a new unwrapped gift or gift card. Each and every person that contributes in any way they can is what makes this program unique and enables us to continue doing this year after year.
