The basic welding course will focus on Shielded Metal Arc Welding "Stick" with 7024, 7018 and 6010 electrodes. Students will perform welds in all positions and various joint configurations on carbon

steel plate. Students will learn basic welding theory, proper electrode selection, machine set up and proper welding and cutting safety. The course will also include Gas Metal Arc Welding "MIG", Flux Cored Arc Welding (Gas Shielded), Gas Tungsten Arc Welding "TIG" and an introduction to open root joints with 6010 electrodes for pipe welding.
