Present Challenges




Although progress has been made, significant regional challenges persist.

High Unemployment



- Luzerne County 9.5%
- Monroe County 9.4%
- Lackawanna County 8.8%
- Pennsylvania 7.6%
- United States 7.5%



Disconnect





- Lack of seniority means less dollars flowing to the region.
- Localized resistance to KOZ and ZOEZ programs.
- Difficult for elected leaders to find every available program and work to bring dollars home.
- Budget shortfalls have forced many governments to cut funding levels or eliminate programs all together.

High-Paying JOBS



- Lack of high-paying jobs or the impression that highpaying jobs do not exist.
- Students are not given opportunities while in school to find the job locally that they want to pursue professionally.



Neither the public sector nor the private sector can not drive economic development alone.



Quality of Life




- Extensive Parks and Recreational opportunities from swimming, skiing, biking, hiking, sports, fishing, kids camps, etc.
