Strawberry Sale Order Form

4-H, in partnership with the Penn State Extension Master Gardeners, will be taking orders for high quality strawberry plants. These plants come from virus indexed, tissue cultured mother plants.

Plants come in bundles of 25, each bundle contains a single variety.

The **cost per bundle is \$12.00**. Orders and payment are **due by May 9, 2016**.

Order by April 25, 2016 to receive a \$2.00 per bundle discount.

The following three varieties will be available for ordering:

- ◇ **Jewel** has large berries with superb quality and flavor. It performs well over a wide range of growing conditions and a successful variety for home gardening due to its overall quality and consistent performance.
- ◇ **Cabot** is known for its huge berries, excellent flavor, color, firmness winter hardiness and disease resistance.
- ◇ **Seascape** will produce a high yield starting just a few months after planting, no matter the season, producing a high yield of large, firm berries with outstanding flavor. They are a great container choice and are one of the most disease resistant day neutral varieties available. (Day Neutral berry plant varieties will produce a constant crop throughout the summer and into the fall, provided temperatures stay within range)
