









Climb aboard an antique trolley for a 10-mile round-trip over Roaring Brook, through a mile long tunnel, to PNC Field on Montage Mountain. Then visit the Electric City Trolley Station & Museum, featuring in-depth historical and interactive exhibits including a special room for children!

Located on the Steamtown National Historic Site, the Electric City Trolley Station & Museum is open year-round from 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM. Trolley excursions run May through October. May through September, enjoy trolley/baseball excursions to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders games at PNC Field. In October, bring the children to our Halloween Party and during the holidays, give them a special treat with Santa on the Trolley.

Something for Everyone at the Trolley Museum!

A 50-seat theater and other fascinating displays bring to life the history of the extensive network that allowed residents of Northeastern Pennsylvania to travel 75 miles on trolleys.

Kid-friendly, interactive exhibits allow children to engage, have fun and be in the driver's seat as they steer a model trolley on a suspended track, build their own Anthracite community on a 24 foot long platform and see how electricity is harnessed for transportation!



At the Trolley Restoration Shop, visitors get an up-close, under-the-skin view of a restored trolley and watch as rare turn-of-the-century, open-car trolleys and sleek interurbans are restored on site.
