Job Corps is a **tuition free**, residential trade school for low-income youth between 16 to 24. We offer trade certificates in more than 30 different programs and give students the chance to finish their high school diploma/GED if needed. The Red Rock Job Corps Center, located in Lopez, PA right outside of Ricketts Glen State Park, is accepting any and all applications at this time for trades in Auto Technician, Collision Repair, Carpentry, Electrical, Plumbing, and Office Administration.

This program is an excellent opportunity for those who are economically challenged, are looking to further their education, and/or are looking for a new career path. With training in some of the nation's most in-demand fields, Job Corps is a great way to change someone's life. Traditionally our program is residential, meaning students would stay on campus through majority of it. Due to the pandemic, our campuses have been closed since March but are currently working on opening again once we receive official word from our Department of Labor. In a meantime, we will happily accept any and all applications.
