PennDOT Has Lifted all Tier Restrictions at 7:00 AM

Dunmore, PA – PennDOT has lifted all tier restrictions that were in place on all Interstates in District 4 (Lackawanna, Luzerne, Pike, Susquehanna, Wyoming and Wayne counties). All speeds are restored to their usual posted limits.

PennDOT is continuing to treat roadways in the area and will continue until roads are clear.

Motorists can check conditions and snow-plow locations on more than 40,000 roadway miles, including color-coded winter conditions on 2,900 miles, by visiting <u>www.511PA.com</u>. 511PA, which is free and available 24 hours a day, provides traffic delay warnings, weather forecasts, traffic speed information and access to more than 860 traffic cameras.

511PA is also available through a smartphone application for iPhone and Android devices, by calling 5-1-1, or by following regional Twitter alerts accessible on the 511PA website.
