- 1. How soon would you be looking to begin services? By at least May 1<sup>st</sup>, but would like to start on 04/28
- 2. Is there a number or nurses and administrative staff you are looking to start with? it depends on the size of the clinic
- 3. How many vaccines are you looking to administer each day? 300 to 3600 have been the sizes we have done
- 4. Will the hours be 10hrs per day, 5 days per week? It has been between 1-3 clinics per week
- 5. Which vaccines will be administered? (Pfizer? Moderna? J&J?) All 3
- 6. Will you be scaling into the growth of your site, or begin with your total numbers? we believe our capacity would max at 4000 per day
- 7. Will you require orientation or trainings prior to our nurses and administrative staff?
  Based on the provider's need
- 8. What locations is staff needed? One location or will it be several? We use multiple sites
- 9. Who is maintaining vaccine and cold chain management? Our provider partners
- 10. Will the county be providing security/police? ves
- 11. Will the county provide the biohazard waste supplies? We pay for the sharps containers and disposal of them
- 12. Will the county create and provide the consent forms? Will they be paper or online? **The County supplies consent forms.**
- 13. Who is providing the EUA? Will that be a part of the scheduling platform? The vaccine providers
- 14. Who is responsible for the standing orders? The vaccine providers
- 15. Who will be responsible for data entry input to the PA Registry (SIIS)? You
- 16. Will the county be capturing different types of insurances? The vaccine provider gathers that information in their registration process
