The park is named after Gino Merli and Joseph Sarnoski, two Lackawanna County Congressional Medal of honor recipients.

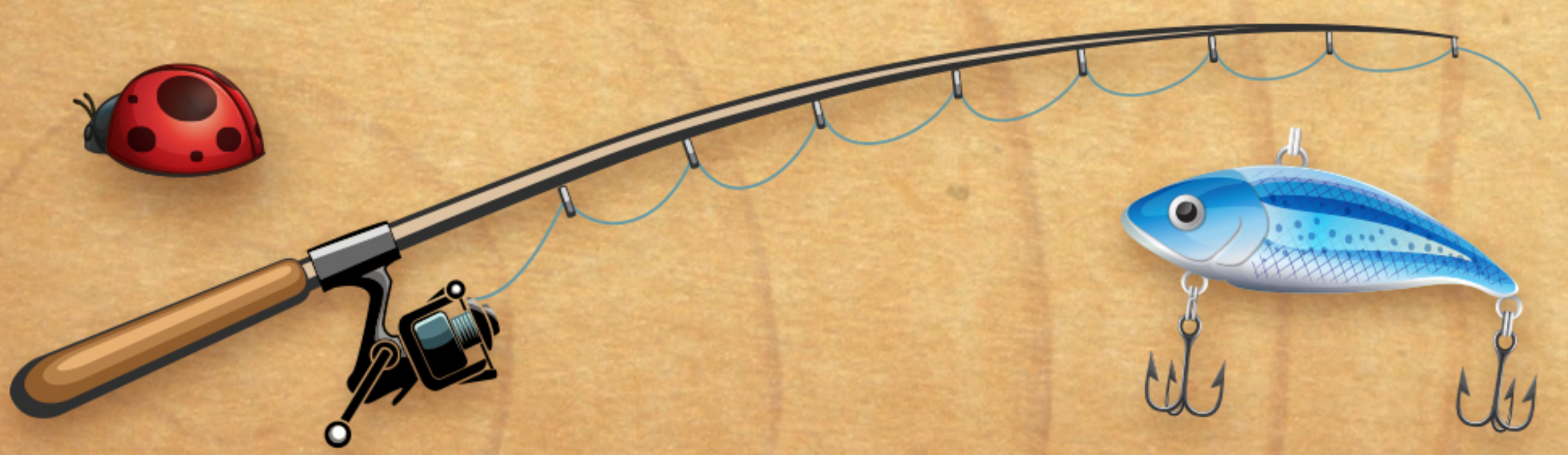
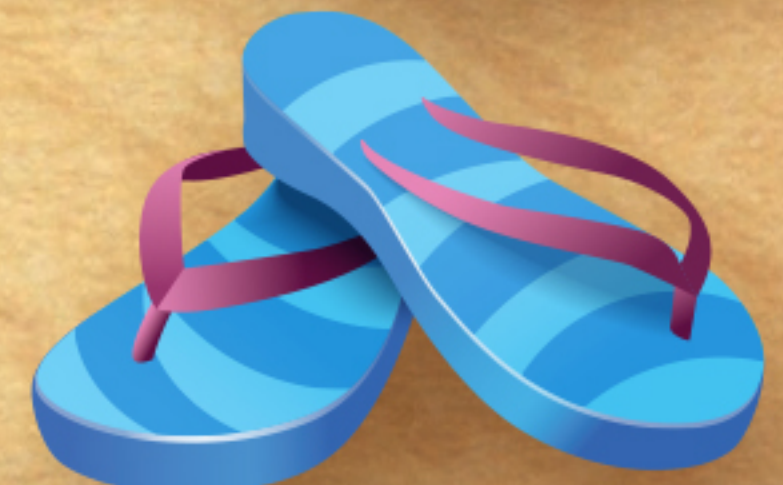
