

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR RFQ # 117/21/1100/03:

1. Section 4. indicates that only Submittals from the Submitters that attended the Pre-Submittal Meeting will be accepted, however, there is no Pre-Submittal meeting information posted. Could the County confirm that attending a Pre-Submittal meeting is not required? **Yes a pre submittal meeting isn't required.**
2. Does the County currently have an agency/individual providing this service? **Yes**
3. What is the historical need for Deaf Interpreters? That is, historically, how many hours per week (on average) has the County required deaf interpreting services? **Only on a as needed basis. There hasn't been a need since FY 18-19 but we keep it on the RFQ in case it is needed.**
4. Would the County consider vendors who propose only remote or video ASL interpreting services? Or is some of the interpreting required to be onsite? Are proposers required to bid on ALL services - both language and ASL, both remote and onsite? **We do require on site for the in person interpreting portion.**
5. What is the County's budget for Deaf Interpreters? **We don't have a separate budget for Deaf Interpreters.**
