Responses to Questions on Bid for Lackawanna County Vendor Huts

Specifications for the Two Rods to Hold Roof Up.

Quantity Needed 2: 36 inch long 1/4" x 1 1/2" flat aluminum prop rod to be attached perpendicular two vertical gable 6 inches down from awning hinge. Threaded rivet nut inserts 1/4-20 to be installed in both the gable and awning at the intersecting point of the prop rod.

Clarification of How Vendor Hut Collapses.

Is prevailing wage required?

No. Lackawanna County is not required to follow prevailing wage requirements.

Is a bond required to place bid?

No. Specifications of the bid did not require this.

Are there requirements for where access to electric is placed?

No. The Manufacturer may decide where it is best to provide an outlet for electricity.

Is the delivery date of Dec. 2 flexible? Can huts be delivered anytime that week?

Yes. The date was set to give the Manufacturer enough time to finish. But they may be delivered earlier if in case of inclement weather, etc. If huts are finished significantly earlier arrangement may be paid to deliver to storage site.

If after the county takes ownership of the Vendor Huts and a person (s) is injured in anyway related to said vendor hut is the fabricator in anyway liable?

If a loss/injury occurs due to either a design or manufacturing defect, the Manufacturer would most likely be liable. If the loss/injury occurs due to incorrect construction or set up of the vendor hut, then most likely the County would be liable or any outside third party entity could be liable that we may employ to construct or assist in setting up the huts.
