HISTORY:

Created in 1836 from Blakely and Providence townships (now extinct) and named in honor of President Thomas Jefferson.

Early settlements date back to 1782 when John Somers made a clearing at the foot of Cobb's Mountain. In 1784 he sold the land to Asa Cobb, who became the township's first permanent settler. The village of Mount Cobb in the township was named in honor of Asa Cobb.
