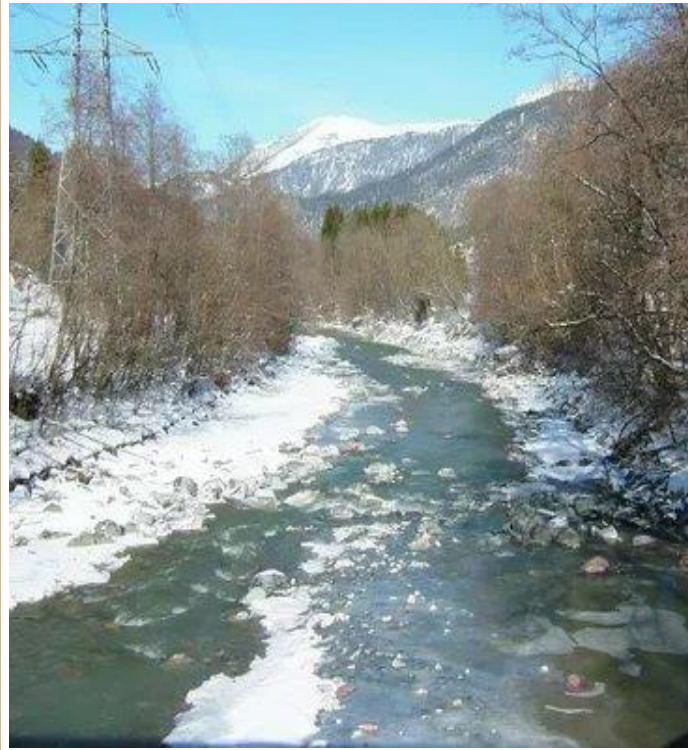

## HISTORY:

Incorporated in 1899 from Fell Township and named after Abraham Vandling, a benevolent mine boss who donated money to build a church in the village.

Vandling was originally called Clintonville, after the Clinton Coal Colliery.

Lumbering was the first industry in the area until coal was discovered near the surface for easy mining.
