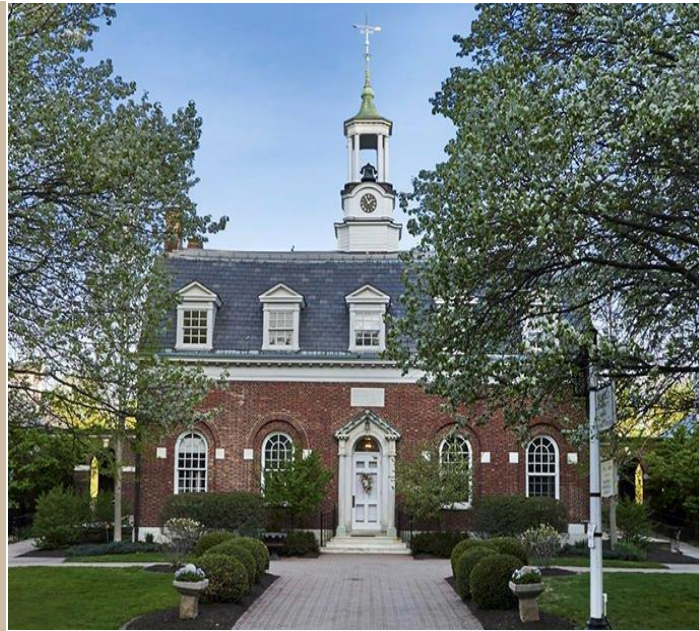

HISTORY:

Created in 1806 from Tunkhannock Township. In the Connecticut claim and survey this township was called Ebbington, in honor of Colonel Ebbington, a Connecticut land agent who granted titles to settlers in the area in the late 1700s.

Pennsylvania landholders changed the name to Abington. In 2011, the township again changed its name to Waverly Township, after the village of Waverly at the center of the township.

The village of Waverly was once an independent borough (incorporated in 1854) but gave up its charter in 1920 to revert back to the township. Waverly was named from the title of a popular novel by Sir Walter Scott.
