HISTORY:

Incorporated in 1851 from Carbondale Twp. as the first city within the anthracite region of the Commonwealth.

The name Carbondale is derived from the presence of coal deposits in the area, “the dale or valley where coal is found.” The first underground coal mine in the US opened in Carbondale, known locally as the “Pioneer City.”

The Wurts brothers formed the Delaware & Hudson Canal Co. to transport coal to Honesdale via a gravity railroad, then to New York by canal.

The very first St. Patrick’s Day Parade in the US was held in the city in 1833.
